Mission

Under the authority of the International President and by International Board delegation, the International Director General, He/She, shall:

- propose, urge and set in operation the International Association's policies, the whole of its activities and operations.
- supervise and merge the Regions*
- be responsible for the associative project

Participative methods are recommended to realize this mission.

*The term « Region » denotes hereafter the Executive Team lead by the Regional Director.

Participation and development of Organization policy

- Jointly with the International Board, propose, formalize then activate in an operational manner the associative project
- Define the Missions within work on the associative project development.
- Suggest innovations with regard to associative policies in the form of undertakings or projects, in line with the policy aims as set by International board.

Prepare and support the work of the International Board

- Monitor the deadlines, and the arrangement of information issues, of analysis and decision.
- Advise on orientations, within the consultative role.
- Ensure efficient means of internal and external communication.

Relations with external partners

- Propose contacts with external partners, prepare dossiers and accompany the President or the International Board Members.
- In the absence of the President or of an authorized administrator, represent the association at meetings with external partners (particularly of partnerships and institutional donors).

Management of the International Directorate: management, finance and HR.

- Define the budgetary and financial policies of the Association
- Define and make enforce human resources policy
- Recruit, form and watch over the regional and mutual directors' development.

Set up, supervise and control the regional leadership teams.

- Set up the IDC, leader executive team.
- Develop the interaction and promote the values and associative priorities within and between the teams.
